WHAT EXACTLY DOES A SEWER MAINTENANCE WORKER I DO?

The primary function involves responsibility for the performance of specialized manual work in variety of tasks related to the cleaning and maintenance of sewer lines and mains. Under the supervision of a higher-level worker or a crew leader, an employee in this class performs semiskilled manual work requiring the use of a variety of sewer equipment and tools to clean and maintain sewer lines and mains. This is physically demanding work requiring knowledge of safety measures and physical strength and agility to work under adverse weather conditions. This is an important role at WEP, and duties will include but are not limited to:

- ❖ Cleans sewer main lines; repairs sewer breaks, cave-ins, and street holes to mains and performs a variety of tasks associated with sewer maintenance activities.
- ❖ May operate motor equipment in the transport of workers, materials and equipment to, from and on work sites.
- ❖ Inspects conditions of sewer lines and mains.
- ❖ Replaces access hole covers that are damaged.
- ❖ Assists in operating sewer-rod equipment and bucket machines.
- ❖ Operates jackhammers and other equipment used in sewer maintenance work.
